The Shreveport Airport Authority, in partnership with the Shreveport Bossier Convention and Tourist Bureau, will host a press conference announcing a movie poster display being installed at the Shreveport Regional Airport on **Wednesday, June 8th at 10:00am on the pedestrian crosswalk bridge at the top of the terminal escalators.**

Twenty-six posters of movies that have been filmed in Shreveport since 2005, including *The Guardian*, *Drive Angry* and *Battle Los Angeles*, have been framed and will be displayed in each of the airport's concourses for the more than half a million passengers that pass through the Shreveport Regional Airport each year.

"This display is another example of just how integrated movies and film making have become in our region," Shreveport Mayor Cedric Glover said. "With that in mind, it's only fitting that we welcome visitors with this dynamic exhibit and remind our citizens traveling abroad that we support this industry and the positive impact it's having on our daily lives."

Shreveport Film Commissioner Arlena Acree, Shreveport-Bossier Convention and Tourist Bureau's Product Development Manager Kathy Melancon, along with Pam Gloriso from the Bossier City Mayor's Office will be on hand to discuss their trip to the Association of Film Commissioners International Conference last week in Los Angeles. Along with Shreveport Mayor Cedric Glover, they met with more than 50 executives in the film industry about bringing more films to our area. The Shreveport Regional Airport has been used as a filming location in more than a dozen movies since 2005.
